Salford Prison Project can help, we can:

- **Help you break the offending cycle**
- **Find accommodation**
- **Provide education & training**
- **Advise on welfare & benefits**
- **Refer to drugs & alcohol teams**
- **Offer peer mentoring**
- **Assist with the rebuilding of family relationships**
- **Provide counseling services**

Are you a relative or partner of someone who is at risk of going to prison or is currently serving time and want to help them choose another life? If you feel that a family member or loved one is in need of support in any of the areas highlighted above we would be keen to hear from you.

If they are currently serving a sentence we are able to visit them in prison using a legal visit in order to engage with them prior to release.

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About the Project

We are a non-statutory organisation, and registered charity, run democratically by our members through an elected management committee. The Centre has both paid and volunteer workers. We rely on funding from a variety of sources, including Big Lottery & charitable organisations.

The aim of the Project is to support offenders and ex-offenders who do not normally receive statutory supervision from the Probation Service but have high rates of reconviction.
